



Market Commentary

The GSE-CI remained at 4,890.6 points last week, leaving the year-to-date and 30-day returns at 0.04% and 4.5% respectively. The generally stable index was due to steady price changes for a few stocks with no substantial weight to noticeably influence the index direction.

Aggregate market turnover plunged by 83.1% w/w to USD 0.2mn, with Scancom Plc dominating trading activity, accounting for 83.4% of the total value traded. Market breadth had an equal proportion of gainers and decliners with a 1:1 ratio. Calbank Plc (\pm 5.7% w/w I GHS 0.37) was the sole gainer, while Atlantic Lithium Ltd (\pm 0.2% w/w I GHS 6.12) was the sole laggard.

MTNGH currently exhibits healthy liquidity at prevailing market levels, with notable block selling activity observed at a price of GHS 2.50 per share. The recent block trades at this level suggest significant market interest and consolidation around this price. The GHS 2.50 level appears to serve as a resistance point for the stock. However, there is growing anticipation that the release of an impressive FY2024 results, could provide the necessary catalyst for a breakout above this threshold.



Market Commentary

The NGX-ASI increased by 1.4% w/w to settle at 103,586.3 points, bringing the year-to-date and 30-day returns to 0.6% and 6.10% respectively. The bullish movement in the index was underpinned by gains in mid-to-large caps.

Aggregate market turnover surged by 105.7% w/w to USD 52.9mn, with Aradel Holdings Plc dominating trading activity, accounting for 18.2% of the total value traded. Market breadth favoured gainers with a 77% ratio. Prestige Assurance Co Plc (+46.0% w/w | NGN 1.5) led the gainers' chart, while Multiverse Plc (-86.8% w/w | NGN 8.1) was the worst laggard.

Nigerian telecommunications operators have submitted a proposal to the Nigerian Communications Commission (NCC) seeking approval to double tariffs. The proposed tariff hike aims to address the impact of escalating operational costs driven by persistent inflationary pressures and rising service delivery expenses. The approval of this proposal would have significant implications for NGX-listed MTN Nigeria. A tariff increase would bolster the company's topline by improving revenue generation, particularly in an environment where inflation continues to erode margins.



Market Commentary

The NSE-ASI increased by 3.2% w/w to settle at 126.4 points, bringing the year-to-date and 30-day returns to 2.3% and 12.6% respectively. The upward movement in the index was due to gains in mid-to-large caps.

Aggregate market turnover tumbled by 79.1% w/w to USD 4.6mn, with KCB Group Plc dominating trading activity, accounting for 12.8% of the total value traded. Market breadth favoured gainers with a 67% ratio. Kenya Power & Lighting Ltd (+21.3% w/w | KES 5.4) led the gainers' chart, while Unga Group Ltd (-10.0% w/w | KES 14.4) was the worst laggard.

Kenya's headline inflation rose to 3.0% y/y in December 2024, primarily driven by rising prices in key sectors. Food and non-alcoholic beverages increased to 4.8% y/y, while transport costs rose modestly by 0.2% y/y. In contrast, some sectors experienced deflation, with prices for housing, water, electricity, gas, and other fuels declining by 0.2% y/y. Notwithstanding the recent upturn, inflation remains firmly within the Central Bank's target range of 2.5% – 7.5% and could potentially keep the monetary authorities on a rate cutting path in 2025. However, external market uncertainty could introduce some sluggishness on rate cutting in early 2025 as US Dollar strength remains a risk to KES stability and market confidence in the year ahead.
